## **Notification on Grade Computation**

### **A] For Classes other than Final Year B. Tech. and Second Year M. Tech.**

#### **2) Definitions, Basis and Applicability:**

- i. In lieu of End Semester Examination (as it is not conducted), 50% of average marks (percentage marks) obtained by a student in the previous semester shall be used for grade computation in each course of current semester.
- ii. The grade computation is for the courses registered (regular) /re-registered in the current semester.
- iii. Current semester: It is the second semester of academic year 2019-20. It includes Semesters II, IV and VI (B.Tech. programme) and Semester II (M. Tech. programme).
- iv. Previous semester: It is the semester immediately preceding the current semester (as defined above).

- v. The total marks obtained in a course which he/she has attempted last(regular/makeup) will be used for the computation of percentage of marks.
- vi. Total marks (sum of ISE 1, MSE, ISE 2 and ESE) in each course (of previous semester) obtained by the student shall be used to calculate the percentage of marks. The computation of performance of the student in the previous semester is based on percentage of marks with 50% weightage.
